KOP Rail Transit Oriented Communities Spring 2022 Open House – March Meeting

Meeting Summary

Through the Spring 2022 Open House Series, SEPTA is looking for feedback on potential connections at and around the KOP Rail stations, including sidewalks and trails. The first meeting in the Spring 2022 Series was a virtual meeting held on March 7th, 2022.

At this meeting, attendees were introduced to the transit-oriented communities study, which looks forward 15 to 20 years to identify how the communities around the stations should develop to meet the goals of the community and maximize the benefits of KOP Rail.

The presentation described the current constraints and opportunities surrounding the stations, including highlighting gaps in walking and cycling infrastructure and sites that are likely to change over the next several decades whether or not KOP Rail occurs because of changing national trends in the retail, office, and housing markets.
