


## **DECEMBER 2023**

#### December 2023:

- Passenger revenue \$20.7 million or 2% above budget and 15% above last year, aided by \$2.3 million from outstanding liability for uncollected tokens
- Unlinked ridership 14.5 million trips or 13% above budget and 18% above last year
- Regional Rail trips increased 21% and Transit 17% over last December
- Average daily trips at 675,000 or 100,000 daily trips above last year
- City's new fall participation in Key Advantage & Zero Fare programs averages 109,500 weekly trips growing 11% above last month
- Contactless payments average 119,825 weekly trips or 10% increase over last month, conversely reducing Fare Kiosk Quick Trip sales by 47%



## Year-to-Date FY 2024 (Jul23 - Dec23):


- Passenger revenue 4% below budget and 5% above last year
- Unlinked ridership 10% above budget and 12% above last year
- Systemwide ridership recovery vs. pre-COVID at 66%, Transit at 68% and Regional Rail at 55%
- Monthly ridership includes automatic passenger counts (APC) for all bus and light rail trolley modes supplementing free ridership counts



## **SEPTA** passenger revenue through December fiscal year-to-date:

FY 2024 passenger revenue \$129.6 million. City Transit generated \$80.3 million, Suburban Transit \$9.1 million, and Regional Rail \$40.2 million. Passenger revenue 4% below budget and 5% above last year.








## SEPTA unlinked ridership through December fiscal year-to-date:

FY 2024 ridership 95.9 million. City Transit recorded 78.5 million, Suburban Transit 7.5 million, and Regional Rail 9.9 million. Ridership 10% above budget and 12% above last year.



### **NOTED IMPACT:**

FY 2017 impacted by RRD rail car shortage during first quarter and six-day City Transit strike in early November 2016.

FY 2018 trips down from modest fare increase & harsh winter, Suburban Transit records 4.2% trip increase.

FY 2019 ridership impacted by City Transit trip losses from competition, roadway congestion, and other factors.

FY 2020 ridership decline due to COVID-19 crisis starting in mid-March 2020 through June year-end.

FY 2021 ridership significantly impacted by COVID-19 throughout fiscal year.

FY 2022 continues to be impacted by COVID-19, ridership 50% of the pre-COVID FY 2019 total of 293 million.

FY 2023 ridership increased to 174 million or 18% above FY 2022 reaching 60% of the pre-pandemic baseline.

FY 2024 forecasted ridership at 179 million or 3% above FY 2023.
